

Congratulations on your purchase!

These li ion batteries are great, they last over a week on a single charge. They are lighter than alkaline batteries - by onte third. They will last many years as they will take hundreds of rechargings.

Batteries must be charged before use.

Unwrap batteries, carefully plug batteries into charger, then plug charger into wall socket. Will operate on 110 or 220 Volts.



The other thing to note:

The charger turns itself off after the battery/s are charged. The charger needs to be unplugged from the wall socket and then plugged back in, to reset the charger, so it will charge again. The charger does this for safety, so the batteries can't be overcharged and cause a hazard.



A couple things to note:

When plugging the batteries into the charger be careful not to damage the connectors. If it doesn't slip in easily, then you have it backwards. Don't force it, if it resists, flip it over, it will slide right in.
